She is an external examiner for the Post-graduate Master and Ph.D. education students at the University of Zimbabwe, College of Health Sciences, Department of Chemical Pathology. She is the Honorary Member of the Italian Society of Clinical Chemistry and Clinical Molecular Biology (**SIBioC**) and the Honorary Member of the Slovak Society of Clinical Biochemistry (**SSCB**). She works for the identification of diagnostic and prognostic markers, multi-omics studies and liquid profiling in cancer, acute and chronic diseases, validation of new tests, and laboratory management.
